



RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY OF WAYNESBORO SMART SCALE ROUND 6 APPLICATION FOR TRANSIT ACCESS PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS, the Staunton-Augusta-Waynesboro Metropolitan Planning Organization (SAWMPO) is the designated regional transportation planning organization, and has the responsibility for developing and carrying out a continuing, cooperative, and comprehensive transportation planning process for the Metropolitan Planning Area; and

WHEREAS, the City of Waynesboro intends to submit a SMART SCALE Round 6 application to construct improvements at six bus stop locations:

- 1) Walmart: tie new sidewalk and crossing Rosser and the proposed crossing of Lennox Lane, 1 bus pad, 3 ADA ramps, 200 linear feet of sidewalk, 1,500 square feet of right of way, and 120 linear feet of pavement marking.
- 2) Walmart Market: 1 bus shelter, 1 bus pad, site grading, and 30 linear feet of block retaining wall.
- 3) Mountain View apartments: tie to existing sidewalk on west side of Ivy Street, 1 bus shelter 1 bus pad, 2 ADA ramps, 175 linear feet of sidewalk, 4 crossing signs, and 2 rectangular rapid flashing beacon (RRFB) systems.
- 4) DMV-Food Lion: tie to existing sidewalk on east side of King Ave, 1 bus shelter, 1 bus pad, 4 ADA ramps, 200 linear feet of sidewalk, 4 crossing signs, general regrading and ditch alignment, 250 linear feet of pavement marking, 2,000 square feet of right of way, and 2 RRFB systems.
- 5) Speedway: 1 bus shelter, 1 bus pad, 1000 square feet of right of way, 30 linear feet of sidewalk, 500 square foot curb and pad buildup in asphalt area, and entrance reconstruction.
- 6) Kroger: 1 bus shelter and 500 square feet right of way.

WHEREAS, this project is not included in the SAWMPO Constrained Long Range Plan and this resolution meets the SMART SCALE Policy Guide requirements for public review of project applications;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the SAWMPO Policy Board does hereby endorse the City of Waynesboro application for the Transit Access Project Improvements to compete for state and federal funding under the SMART SCALE Program Round 6 Application Cycle.
